ST. BARBE BY ELECTION SUMMARY

On January 8, 2001 a Writ of Election was issued for a By Election in the Electoral District of St. Barbe to be held on January 30, 2001. The By Election was called to fill a vacancy created by the October 28th resignation of Mr. Chuck Furey who was nominated as a candidate for the November 20, 2000 Federal Election.

The Revised List of Electors that was completed in August, 2000 was used as the Official List. There were 7562 registered electors on the Official List and another 446 electors sworn in on polling day.

Nomination day was held on Saturday, January 20, 2001 with three candidates officially nominated at the close, namely: Stephen Carey for the New Democratic Party; Joseph P. Kennedy for the Liberal Party and Wallace Young for the Progressive Conservative Party.

An additional advance poll was approved for the By Election in the Community of Black Duck Cove for a total of three advance polls. Some 76 applications for special mail in ballots were received and approved which represented an increase of over 500% from the February 9, 1999 General Election whereby 15 applications were approved.

The preliminary count on election night resulted in a total of 4789 votes. There was a total of 127 votes cast at three advance polls; 77 votes cast by special mail in ballot; and 4585 votes cast at 39 regular polls. Mr. Carey received 327, Mr Kennedy received 2212 votes; and Mr. Young received 2235. There were a total of 15 rejected ballots and 6 cancelled ballots.

The official addition of the votes was conducted on Friday, February 2, 2001. The results remained unchanged for Mr. Kennedy and Mr. Young, while Mr. Carey received one less vote for a total of 326. This change resulted in a reduction in the total number of votes cast to 4788. Mr. Wallace Young was declared elected after the official addition of the votes and was sworn in as a member of the House of Assembly on Wednesday, February 21, 2001. The results of both St. Barbe and The Straits and White Bay North By Elections left representation in the House of Assembly with 30 Liberals, 16 Progressive Conservatives and 2 New Democrats.

The Office of the Chief Electoral Officer spent approximately \$58,000 in total in administering the By Election pursuant to the provisions of the legislation including wages as set out for the Returning Officer, Election Clerk and 93 Election Officials.

THE STRAITS & WHITE BAY NORTH BY ELECTION SUMMARY

On Monday, January 8, 2001 a Writ of Election was issued for a By Election in the Electoral District of The Straits & White Bay North to be held on Tuesday, January 30, 2001. The By Election was called to fill a vacancy created by the October 16, 2000 resignation of Premier Brian Tobin who sought the nomination in the federal district of Bonavista-Trinity-Conception for the November 20, 2000 Federal Election.

The Revised List of Electors that was completed in August, 2000 was used as the Official List. There were 7689 registered electors on the Official List and another 591 electors sworn in on polling day.

Nomination day was held on Saturday, January 20, 2001 with four candidates officially nominated at the close; namely, Fred Mitchelmore; Holly Patey for the New Democratic Party; Ross Pilgrim for the Liberal Party; and Trevor Taylor for the Progressive Conservative Party.

An additional advance poll was approved for the By Election in the Community of Flowers Cove for a total of three advance polls. A total of 115 applications for special mail in ballots were received and approved which represented an increase of over 630% from the February 9, 1999 General Election whereby 18 applications were approved.

A total of 5180 votes were cast in the By Election comprised of 145 votes cast at three advance polls; 102 votes cast by special mail in ballot; and 4933 votes cast at 46 regular polls. Mr. Mitchelmore received 160 votes, Ms. Patey received 41 votes; Mr. Pilgrim received 2374 votes and Mr. Taylor received 2590 votes. There were a total of 15 rejected ballots and 5 cancelled ballots.

The official addition of the votes was conducted on Friday, February 2, 2001. The results reconfirmed the preliminary results on election night. Mr. Trevor Taylor was declared elected after the official addition of the votes and was sworn in as a member of the House of Assembly on Wednesday, February 21, 2001. The results of both St. Barbe and The Straits & White Bay North By Elections left representation in the House of Assembly with 30 Liberals, 16 Progressive Conservatives and 2 New Democrats.

The Office of the Chief Electoral Officer spent approximately \$65,000 in total administering the By Election pursuant to the provisions of the Elections Act including wages as set out for the Returning Officer, Election Clerk and 100 Election Officials.
