BONAVISTA NORTH BY ELECTION SUMMARY

On July 2, 2002, a Writ of Election was issued for a By Election to be held in the Electoral District of Bonavista North on July 24, 2002. The By Election was called to fill a vacancy created by the April 2, 2002 resignation of Mr. Beaton Tulk.

The Revised List of Electors that was completed in February, 2002 was used as the Official List. There were 7784 registered electors on the Official List and another 848 electors sworn in on polling day.

Nomination Day was held on Sunday, July 14, 2002 with three candidates officially nominated, namely: Harry Harding for the Progressive Conservative Party; Beaton Tulk for the Liberal Party; and John Whelan for the New Democratic Party.

There were a total of 285 applications for special mail in ballots received and approved and only 17 not returned to the Chief Electoral Office by the deadline, Sunday, July 21, 2002 at 4:00 p.m.

The preliminary count on election night resulted in a total of 6016 votes cast. There were a total of 429 votes cast at four advance polls; 268 votes cast by special mail in ballot; and 5319 votes cast at 48 regular polls.

Mr. Harding received 3424 votes, Mr. Tulk received 2540 votes and Mr. Whelan received 35 votes. There were a total of 17 rejected ballots and 2 cancelled ballots.

The official addition of the votes was conducted on Saturday, July 27, 2002. The results remained unchanged from the preliminary results on election night. Mr. Harding was declared elected after the official addition of the votes and was sworn in as a member of the House of Assembly on Wednesday, August 14, 2002. The results of the Bonavista North By Election left representation in the House of Assembly with 27 Liberals, 19 Progressive Conservatives and 2 New Democrats.

The Office of the Chief Electoral Officer spent approximately \$69,000 in administering the By Election pursuant to the provisions of the legislation.
