Candidates that are successful in being elected to the House of Assembly, after being sworn in as Member of the House of Assembly, will be required to complete and submit a Private Interest Disclosure booklet to the Commissioner for Legislative Standards.

Private Interest Disclosures are required under the **House of Assembly Act, Part II, *Conflict of Interest***: <http://www.assembly.nl.ca/legislation/sr/statutes/h10.htm>. Review Part II - Sections 20 to 53.

Private Interest Disclosure booklet includes information on:

- assets
- liabilities
- sources of incomes
- financial obligations
- inheritances
- trusteeship
- partnerships
- shares
- executive posts
- volunteer groups

for the Members of the House of Assembly, their spouses and dependents.

As a part of the Oath of Office and prior to being permitted to take their seats, all Members must swear/affirm to uphold [House of Assembly - NL - Members' Code of Conduct](#).
