Note 1

A listing of contributions made to the registered political parties relating to the General Election of October 11, 2011 is included in the annual filing of the Political Parties. This statement details expenditures of the political parties related to the General Election of October 11, 2011. The details of contributions of amounts greater than \$100 are included and listed in a separate report titled "Report of the Chief Electoral Officer on Election Finances of Registered Political Parties for the Period January 1, 2011 to December 31, 2011"

Note 2

A registered party's campaign expenditure limit is calculated by multiplying the expense factor for 2011 by the number of persons on the revised list of electors in each of the districts in which the party has a candidate.

A registered party contesting all 48 districts would have a campaign expenditure limit of:

381,047 X \$4.083 per voter = \$1,555,815
