**Note 1**

A listing of contributions made to the registered political parties relating to the General Election of May 16, 2019 is included in the annual filing of the Political Parties. This statement details expenditures of the political parties related to the General Election of May 16, 2019. The details of contributions of amounts greater than \$100 are included and listed in a separate report titled "Annual Report on Election Finances January 1, 2019 to December 31, 2019". **Note 2**

A registered party's campaign expenditure limit is calculated by multiplying the expense factor for 2019 by the number of persons on the revised list of electors in each of the districts in which the party has a candidate.

A registered party contesting all 40 districts would have a campaign expenditure limit of:  
350,792 X \$4.672 per voter = \$1,638,900

The Liberal Party had candidates in all 40 districts. Their expenditure limit is \$1,638,900

The PC Party had candidates in 39 districts. Their expenditure limit is \$1,605,872

The NDP had candidates in 14 districts. Their expenditure limit is \$617,742

**Note 3**

The NL Alliance did not record any expenditures for the 2019 General Election. They were not required to file any financial statements.
