**Note 1**

A listing of contributions made to the registered political parties relating to the 2021 General Election is included in the annual filing of the Political Parties. This statement details the expenditures of the political parties related to the 2021 General Election.

**Note 2**

A registered party's campaign expenditure limit is calculated by multiplying the expense factor for 2020 by the number of persons on the revised list of electors in each of the districts in which the party has a candidate. A registered party contesting all 40 districts has a campaign expenditure limit of: \$1,766,271

The Liberal Party and PC Party ran candidates in all 40 districts. Their expenditure limit is \$1,766,271

The NDP ran candidates in 33 districts. Their expenditure limit is \$1,466,308

**Note 3**

The NL Alliance did not record any expenditures for the 2021 General Election. They were not required to file any financial statements.
